Castle Facade For 12" Fashion Dolls Free Crochet Pattern



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<u>GAUGE:</u> 4 sc = 1", 4 rows sc = 1" <u>FINISHED SIZE:</u> 12" X 15" and about 2" deep.

<u>TOWER (MAKE 2):</u> <u>ROW 1:</u> With white and H hook ch-55, sc 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from hook, sc ea ch across, ch-1, turn. (54 sts) <u>ROW 2-3:</u> Sc ea st across, ch-1, turn. <u>ROW 4:</u> Sc next 15 sts, leave remaining sts unworked, ch-1, turn. (15 sts) <u>ROW 5-54:</u> Sc ea st across, ch-1, turn. At the end of row 54 fasten off. <u>ROW 55:</u> With white yarn and H hook join last st row 3, ch-1, sc sa st as ch-1, sc next 15 sts, leave remaining sts unworked, ch-1, turn. (15 sts) <u>ROW 56-105:</u> Rep row 4-54. Do not fasten off. <u>ROW 106:</u> Sc next 15 sts, ch-24, sl st 1<sup>st</sup> st corresponding side, fasten off. <u>ROW 107:</u> With white yarn and H hook join end row 106, ch-1, sc sa st as ch-1, sc ea st and ch across, ch-1, turn. (54 sts) <u>ROW 108-110:</u> Sc ea st across, ch-1, turn. <u>ROW 108-110:</u> Sc ea st across, ch-1, turn. <u>ROW 111:</u> Sc next 12 sts, leave remaining sts unworked, ch-1, turn. (12 sts) <u>ROW 112-115:</u> Sc ea st across, ch-1, turn. At the end of row 115 fasten off.

<u>ROW 116:</u> With white yarn and H hook join end row 110, ch-1, sc sa st as ch-1, sc next 11 sts, leave remaining sts unworked, ch-1, turn. (12 sts)

ROW 117-120: Sc ea st across, ch-1, turn. At the end of row 120 fasten off.

<u>ROW 121:</u> With white yarn and H hook count over 6 sts from end st of row 115, join next st, ch-1, sc sa st as ch-1, sc next 5 sts, leave remaining sts unworked, ch-1, turn. (6 sts)

ROW 122-125: Sc ea st across, ch-1, turn. (6 sts) At the end of row 125 fasten off.

<u>ROW 126:</u> With white yarn and H hook count over 6 sts from end row 120, join next st, ch-1, sc sa st as ch-1, sc next 5 sts, leave remaining sts unworked, ch-1, turn. (6 sts)

ROW 127-130: Sc ea st across, ch-1, turn. At the end of row 130 fasten off.

FLOOR (MAKE 2):

<u>ROW 1:</u> With grey yarn and H hook ch-37, sc  $2^{nd}$  ch from hook, sc ea ch across, ch-1, turn. (36 sts) <u>ROW 2-10</u>: Sc ea st across, ch-1, turn. At the end of row 10 fasten off.

DOOR:

<u>ROW 1:</u> with grey yarn and H hook ch-51, sc  $2^{nd}$  ch from hook, sc ea ch across, ch-1, turn. (50 sts) <u>ROW 2-32</u>: In Bk Lp only sc ea st across, ch-1, turn. At the end of row 32 fasten off.

## PUTTING IT TOGETHER:

Place one of the castle sides and one of the floor on the foam board. Carefully trace around ea piece. Measure in 1-4" on all sides and use that line as you cutting line. Using the craft knife cut the foam board out.

On the castle board measure in 1-1/2" in on ea long side. Draw a line and then score this line being careful to only cut through one side and foam core. This will form the sidewalls of the castle later.

With needle and yarn sew the two-castle facades tog sandwiching the foam board in the center. Do the same with the floor crochet pieces and the cut to size foam board.

Bend the castle's sides inward. Sew the floor inside these two walls and the front. Sew the bottom of the door to the bottom of the castle. Either leave open or sew snaps to the top of the door and castle to allow it to close.
