## Three Dress Set <br> Small Bratz Doll <br> Free Crochet Pattern



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Donna's Crochet Designs

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MATERIALS:Red Heart Luster Sheen yarn in White, Think Pink and Tea Leaf, F crochet hook or hook to obtain gauge, 2 sm snaps per dress, needle and thread.

GAUGE: $5 \mathrm{sc}=1 ", 6$ rows $\mathrm{sc}=1 "$
FINISHED SIZE: Will fit " tall Bratz Kids doll
SKIRT:
ROW 1: With White and F hook ch-12, sc $2^{\text {nd }}$ ch from hook, sc ea ch across, ch-1, turn. (11 sts)
ROW 2: ( 2 sc next st, sc next 2 sts) 3 times, leave remaining sts unworked, ch-1, turn. ( 12 sts )
ROW 3: ( 2 sc next st, sc next 2 sts) across, ch-1, turn. ( 16 sts )
ROW 4: ( 2 sc next st, sc next st) across, ch-1, turn. ( 24 sts )
RND 5: Sl st in $1^{\text {st }}$ made row 4, ch-1, turn, sc ea st around, sl st top beg sc, ch-1, turn. ( 24 sts )
RND 6-13: Sc ea st around, sl st top beg sc, ch-1, turn.
RND 14: ( 2 sc next st, sc next 5 sts) around, sl st top beg sc, ch-1, turn. (28 sts)
RND 15: (2 sc next st, sc next 6 sts) around, sl st top beg sc, ch-1, turn. ( 32 sts )
RND 16-20: Sc ea st around, sl st top beg sc, ch-1, turn.
RND 21: (2 sc next st, sc next 3 sts) around, sl st top beg sc, ch-1, turn. (40 sts)
RND 22-26: Sc ea st around, sl st top beg sc, ch-1, turn. End rnd 26 fasten off.

## TOP:

ROW 1: With White and F hook join in last st row 1 of skirt, ch-1, sc sa st as beg ch-1, sc ea st across, ch-1, turn. (11 sts)
ROW 2-3: Sc ea st across, ch-1, turn.
ROW 4: Sc next 4 sts, sk next st, ch-4, sc next 3 , sk next, ch-4, sc last 2 , fasten off.
Sew 2 sm snaps at back opening.
PINK RUFF EL DRESS:
Make one basic dress in white.

## TOP RUFFLE:

ROW 1: With Think Pink and F hook ch-18, sc $2^{\text {nd }} \mathrm{ch}$ from hook, sc ea ch across, turn. ( 17 sts )
ROW 2: Ch-3, work 3 dc in ea st around, turn. (51 sts)
ROW 3: (Ch-3, sl st next st, ch-4, sl st next st) across, fasten off.
With needle and thread sew ruffle around top edge of dress.
BOTTOM RUFFLE:
ROW 1: With Think Pink and F hook ch-137, sc $2^{\text {nd }}$ ch from hook, sc ea ch across, turn. (136 sts)
ROW 2: Ch-3, work 3 dc in ea st around, turn. ( 408 sts)
ROW 3: (Ch-3, sl st next st, ch-4, sl st next st) across, fasten off.
With needle and thread sew ruffle around bottom edge of dress beginning at the front and to one side. Pull remaining ruffle to the dress's waist and let cascade down. Tack at waist to hold.

## MIDDLE AGES DRESS:

Make a basic dress in white.
VEST:
ROW 1: With Tea Leaf and F hook ch-14, sc $2^{\text {nd }}$ ch from hook, sc ea ch across, ch-1, turn. (13 sts) ROW 2: Sc ea st across, ch-1, turn.
ROW 3: Sc next 2 sts, ch-4, sk next, sc next 7, ch-4, sk next, sc next 2, fasten off.
ch-1, turn. (20 sts)
ROW 2-3: Sc ea st across, ch-1, turn.
ROW 4: (2 sc next st, sc next 3 sts) across, ch-1, turn. ( 25 sts )
ROW 5-6: Sc ea st across, ch-1, turn.
ROW 7: (2 sc next st, sc next 4 sts) across, ch-1, turn. (30 sts)
ROW 8-9: Sc ea st across, ch-1, turn.
ROW 10: ( 2 sc next st, sc next 5 sts ) across, ch-1, turn. ( 35 sts )
ROW 11-12: Sc ea st across, ch-1, turn.
ROW 13: ( 2 sc next st, sc next 6 sts) across, ch-1, turn. (40 sts)
ROW 14-15: Sc ea st across, ch-1, turn.
ROW 16-35: Sk $1^{\text {st }}$ st, sc ea st across, ch-1, turn. End row 35 fasten off. (Row 16: 39 sts)(Row 35: 20 sts)
Place vest one doll, lace a strand of Tea Left yarn through the sts at sides of vest and tie in a bow.

## SLEEVE:

RND 1: With Tea Leaf and F hook ch-8, sl st to form a ring, ch-1, sc in ea ch around, sl st top beg sc, ch-1, turn. (8 sts)
RND 2: Sc ea st around, sl st top beg sc, ch-1, turn.
RND 3-6: 2 sc next st, sc ea st to last st, 2 sc last st, sl st top beg sc, ch-1, turn. End rnd 6 fasten off. (10 sts)(12 sts)(14 sts)(16 sts)
-Make 2. Slide sleeve half way up ea arm.

## OVERLAPPING COLORS DRESS:

ROW 1: With Think Pink and F hook ch-16, sc $2^{\text {nd }}$ ch from hook, sc ea ch across, ch-1, turn. ( 15 sts) ROW 2: 2 sc $1^{\text {st }}$ st, ( 2 sc next st, sc next 2 sts) 4 times, sc last st, ch-1, turn. (19 sts)
ROW 3: Sk $1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{st}$, ( 2 sc next st, sc next 2 sts ) across, ch-1, turn. ( 24 sts )
ROW 4-14: Sk $1^{\text {st }}$ st, sc ea st across, ch-1, turn. End row 14 fasten off. (23 sts)(22 sts)(21 sts)(20 sts)(19 sts)(18 sts)(17 sts)(16 sts)(15 sts)(14 sts)(13 sts)
Sew around waist of dress with opening at the side. Sew opening close.

## GREEN OVERLAPPING SKIRT:

ROW 1: With Tea Leaf and F hook ch-25, sc $2^{\text {nd }}$ ch from hook, sc ea ch across, ch-1, turn. ( 24 sts)
ROW 2-11: Sc ea st across, ch-1, turn.
ROW 12: Sk $1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{st}$, sc ea st across to last st, sl st last st, ch-1, turn. (22 sts)
ROW 13-21: Sk sl st and $1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{sc}$, sc ea st across, to last st, sl st last st, ch-1, turn. End row 21 fasten off. ( 20 sts )(18 sts)(16 sts)(14 sts)(12 sts)(10 sts)(8 sts)(6 sts)(4 sts)
Sew green skirt 2 rows below where you sewed the pink skirt keeping opening to other side of dress. Sew opening close.

## SLEEVE:

ROW 1: With Think Pink and F hook ch-4, sc $2^{\text {nd }}$ ch from hook, sc ea ch across, ch-1, turn. ( 3 sts)
ROW 2-3: Sc ea st across, ch-1, turn.
ROW 4: Sc ea st across, join Tea Leaf, fasten off Think Pink, ch-1, turn.
ROW 5-6: Sc ea st across, ch-1, turn.
ROW 7: Sk $1^{\text {st }}$ st, sc next 2 sts, ch-1, turn. (2 sts)
ROW 8: Sc $1^{\text {st }}$ st, sl st last st, ch-1, turn. (1 st)
ROW 9: Sk sl st, sc last st, fasten off.
-Make 2. Sew row 9 over row 1 . Sew sleeve around sleeve opening.
